# NJ COVID-19 Hotlines for COVID-19 Vaccine

A phone line to help New Jersey residents get a COVID-19 vaccination appointment went live on Monday, January 25<sup>th</sup>. The phone line **(855)** 568-0545 will be staffed with agents daily from 8am – 8pm to help residents, especially seniors sign up for COVID-19 vaccination appointments. The phone line is expected to be inundated with callers and residents are asked to be patient as the phone line is set up and vaccine continues to arrive to NJ.

In addition to the State line, **Somerset County** has set up a call center for residents to call and get answers about both COVID-19 testing and vaccinations. Call **(908) 231-7155** M-F 8:30am-8pm and Sat from 10am-4pm. **Morris County** residents can continue to utilize the COVID-19 Hotline **(973) 829-8250** which is staffed 7 days a week during business hours.

#### **COVID-19 Variant Updates**

Two confirmed cases of the UK virus variant identified in NJ.

- Confirmed cases include an Ocean County resident and young traveler in northern NJ. The cases do not appear to be linked.
- It is likely that there are more cases in NJ that have not been detected.
- The virus variants are more easily spread and could lead to increased cases. The public is urged to stay vigilant with prevention actions, such as wearing masks, social distancing, washing hands often, and adhering to isolation and quarantine recommendations.

# **COVID-19 School Guidance**

Since the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic, the NJDOH has provided local health departments with guidance known as <a href="#">"COVID-19 Public Health</a>
<a href="#">Recommendations for Local Health Departments for K-12 Schools"</a>. This is based off current CDC guidance.

This guidance is meant to be used by local health departments to use in partnership with school districts. This guidance uses a regional approach to determine risk within the broader school community and puts protocols into place to ensure when a COVID-19 case is identified, individuals are excluded as efficiently as possible. It is based on what is currently known about transmission and severity of COVID-19 and is subject to change as more information is discovered.

The Bernards Township Health Department adheres to this guidance and works with all schools within jurisdiction to advise school staff and work through all scenarios and questions. The most recent <u>update to this guidance</u> was January 19<sup>th</sup>, 2021 and was sent out to Health Departments and Schools on January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

#### **How to Get Vaccinated**

NJ is currently experiencing a vaccine shortage. As time goes on and a vaccine becomes more available, expect more appointment slots to open and more sites to open. For now, there are only 3 ways to get vaccinated:

- 1. Make an appointment directly with one of the many designated vaccination sites across the state. Click here to view a full list of designated vaccination sites.
- Pre-register on NJVSS, and you will be notified when an appointment is available to you. <u>Click here to visit</u> the NJ Vaccine Scheduling System.
- Select healthcare facilities, including many hospitals, are offering vaccines directly to their workers. If you work at one of the facilities, you can contact your employer to learn if the vaccine is available to you from your employer.
