NJ Vaccine Call Center: 75+ Programs

The goal of this program is to provide scheduling support, predominantly through dedicated appointments to ensure 75+ seniors are able to access appointments.

Outbound calls to 75+ individuals based on the NJVSS wait-list to schedule appointments at the following locations:

- Gloucester mega-site
- Inspira Health (Mullica Hill and Vineland)
- Walmart (60 sites state-wide launching 3/8)
- Shop Rite (64 sites state-wide, launch TBD)

Separate senior specific number (856) 249-7007 to be used for inbound calls for the following:

- Rescheduling of dedicated appointments.
- Registration and addition of 75+ to NJVSS wait-list
- Scheduling at other NJVSS sites.

Updates from the Governor's Office

- Wedding receptions may proceed at 35% of a venue's indoor capacity up to 150 persons, and up to 150 people outdoors.
- Sleepaway camps will be able to safely resume their operations this summer.

Expanded Eligibility for the COVID-19 Vaccine in NJ Beginning Monday 3/15 - the following categories are eligible for vaccination

- Educators, including support staff, in Pre-K through 12th grade settings. Childcare workers in licensed and registered settings
- Public and local transportation workers, including bus, taxi, rideshare, and airport employees; NJ Transit workers; and Motor Vehicle Commission staff
- Public safety workers who are not sworn law enforcement or fire professionals, including probation officers and fire safety inspectors
- Migrant farm workers
- Members of tribal communities
- Individuals experiencing homelessness and those living in shelters, including domestic violence shelters.

Beginning Monday 3/29 - the following categories are eligible for vaccination

- Food production, agriculture, and food distribution
- Eldercare and support
- Warehousing and logistics, medical supply chain
- Social services support staff, hospitality
- Elections personnel, Judicial system
- Postal and shipping services
- Clergy

How Long Should I Quarantine?

The safest option is to stay home for 14 days. If you cannot stay home for 14 days due to economic or other hardship, there are **2 options**. **1)** No Test Option – Stay home for 10 days. If you stay symptom free for 10 days, quarantine ends. Monitor symptoms and wear a mask and social distance through day 14. **2)** Test Option – Stay home for 7 days. Get tested Day 5,6, or 7. Stay home while awaiting results. If the test is negative and you're symptom free, quarantine ends. Monitor symptoms, wear a mask and social distance through Day 14.
