What Can I Do When I'm Vaccinated?

VACCINATED with VACCINATED

- After receiving the final dose and waiting 14 days (after the second of a two dose vaccine or one dose of a single dose vaccine), vaccinated persons can interact without restrictions among other vaccinated and those immune due to previous infection (in the past 3 months).
- Vaccinated persons **do not need to quarantine** if exposed to a positive COVID-19 case.
- Remain vigilant continue to adhere to infection prevention precautions in public like wearing a mask and physical distancing.
- Continue to avoid medium/large gatherings.
- Get tested if experiencing COVID-19 symptoms.

Travel Guidance for Vaccinated Individuals (at this time)

<u>New Jersey</u> strongly discourages all non-essential interstate travel. Individuals that have been vaccinated should continue to follow the State's travel advisory.

Travelers and residents returning from **any U.S. state or territory** beyond the immediate region (NY/PA) should self-quarantine at home and follow recommendations from the CDC:

recommendations from the CDC:

- If travel is unavoidable, travelers should get tested 1-3 days before the trip and again 3-5 days after the trip.
- If travelers test positive, they should self-isolate for at least 10 days and should postpone travel during that time.
- If travelers test negative, they should travel, then **quarantine for a full 7 days** after travel.
- If testing is not available after traveling (or if the results are delayed), travelers should **quarantine for 10 days after travel**.

VACCINATED with UNVACCINATED

- Vaccinated persons can visit with unvaccinated people from a single household who are at low risk for severe COVID-19 disease indoors without masks or social distancing.
- Wear masks, practice physical distancing and adhere to other prevention measures when visiting people who are at risk for severe COVID-19 or who have an unvaccinated household member at risk for severe COVID-19 disease.
- Vaccinated persons can potentially be symptomatic or asymptomatic carriers of the virus and transmit it.
- Adhere to all infection prevention precautions in public.
- Unvaccinated persons should quarantine if exposed to a positive COVID-19 case.

UNVACCINATED with UNVACCINATED

- If unvaccinated persons come from multiple households, there is a higher risk of COVID-19 transmission. Anyone involved should take infection prevention precautions including wearing a mask, physical distancing and visiting outdoors or in a well-ventilated space.
- Continue to **avoid** medium/large gatherings.
- In public, continue to adhere to all infection prevention precautions – wear a mask, practice physical distancing, wash your hands and avoid large gatherings.
- Unvaccinated individuals should quarantine if exposed to a positive COVID-19 case and get tested if they experience any COVID-19 symptoms.

Updates from the Governor's Office

- Outdoor gatherings that are not religious services or ceremonies, political events, weddings, funerals, or memorial services will be capped at 50 individuals.
- Effective March 19th, the following businesses can <u>increase indoor capacity to 50%</u>: Restaurants, recreational and amusements, gym and fitness clubs, barbershops, salons, and other personal care businesses.
