COVID-19 Restrictions Being Lifted

Lots of updates have been happening in New Jersey and guidance is constantly changing. Here is a rundown of some of the newest guidance restrictions being lifted.

- Indoor Mask Mandate Being lifted as of May 28th:
 - Businesses and entities overseeing indoor spaces may continue requiring individuals to wear a face mask.
 - Face masks will still be required in State offices and worksites that are closed to public such as warehousing and manufacturing facilities.
 - Individuals should continue wearing a face mask in healthcare settings, correctional facilities, homeless shelters, airplanes, buses, trains and other forms of public transportation as well as airports, train stations and bus terminals.
 - Individuals should continue wearing a face mask in childcare settings, youth summer camps, private and parochial preschool programs, and elementary and secondary schools.
 - Unvaccinated individuals are strongly encouraged to continue wearing face masks in any indoor public setting.
- Social Distancing Being lifted as of May 28^{th.}
 - Businesses may continue to require individuals to maintain six feet of social distancing.
 - Individuals in the above listed locations (healthcare settings, correctional facilities, etc) should also continue to maintain social distancing,
 - Unvaccinated individuals are strongly encouraged to continue social distancing.
- Dance floors, bars and restaurants:
 - The Governor is removing all prohibitions from dance floors and bars and restaurants and from ordering food and drinks while standing at bars and restaurants effective May 28th.
- Indoor Gatherings All capacity restrictions lifted as of June 4^{th.}
- Group limits in childcare classes Lifted as of May 26th.

HIPPAA and COVID-19 Vaccines

Effective Friday, June 4th employers may allow employees who can verify they are vaccinated to forego masking and social distancing. Employers may also rescind requirements to accommodate remote working arrangements and to reduce onsite staffs to the minimal number necessary.

As the vaccine becomes more readily available and individuals begin to return to work, a very common question we've received is "Is my employer allowed to ask me about my vaccination status? Isn't that against HIPAA?"

HIPAA (Health Insurance Portability and

Accountability Act of 1996) is a federal law that protects sensitive patient health information from being disclosed without the patient's consent or knowledge. This only pertains to the healthcare providers, health plans, health clearinghouses and business associates of these entities.

A vaccine card does qualify as protected health information however HIPAA does not apply to most businesses and HIPAA does not protect information that patient shares about themselves. Proof of vaccination has historically been required in other instances like school registration, travel to certain counties and for employment in certain fields.
