ORDINANCE NO. 1088-2020

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER XXIII, TITLED "LAND DEVELOPMENT" OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES SUBSECTION 98(C), TITLED "OTHER PENALTIES"

WHEREAS Chapter 23, Titled "Land Development" of the revised general ordinances, Subsection 98(c) Titled "Other Penalties" reads;

c. Other Penalties. Unless otherwise specifically provided herein, any violation of the provisions of this chapter shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed two hundred (\$200.00) dollars or by imprisonment in the County jail for a term not to exceed ninety (90) days, or both, at the discretion of the Municipal Court. Each day the violation shall continue after a notice and a reasonable opportunity to correct or remedy the violation shall constitute a separate violation.

And;

WHEREAS it is the recommendation of the Mayor and Council that a change be made to Other Penalties as below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Peapack and Gladstone, in the County of Somerset and State of New Jersey, that Chapter XXIII, Titled "Land Development" of the revised general ordinances, Subsection 98(c) Titled "Other Penalties" is amended as follows: (Deletions Crossed Out; Insertions in **Bold**)

c. Other Penalties. Unless otherwise specifically provided herein, any violation of the provisions of this chapter shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed two hundred (\$200.00) dollars or by imprisonment in the County jail for a term not to exceed ninety (90) days, or both, at the discretion of the Municipal Court. Each day the violation shall continue after a notice and a reasonable opportunity to correct or remedy the violation shall constitute a separate violation.

Section 23-98 c. Other Penalties

If any person owning, leasing, occupying or having charge of any premises violates any of the zoning provisions, that person, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by one or more of the following: a fine not less than \$300 nor more than \$2,000, imprisonment for a term not to exceed 90 days or a period of community service not to exceed 90 days for each offense. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which such violation is permitted to exist.
