



Grilling Safety

Now that the weather is getting warmer, it's time to break out the grill and start heating up for your summer meals!

As simple as grilling can be, there's a few things that can go wrong in terms of foodborne illness, heat injuries, cross contamination, and more.

Private Well Owners!

Save the Date! Find out if your drinking water is safe through low-cost testing offered by the nonprofit Raritan Headwaters Association (RHA). Several well testing events are happening this season, including in nearby **Bernardsville from June 2nd – June 6th at Borough Hall.** Tests are available for a range of potential contaminants, including coliform bacteria, nitrates, arsenic, lead, radon, volatile organic chemicals, polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), and more.

Residents may purchase the kits they want in-person during the designated days using a check (no cash). Kits can also be reserved ahead of time online with a credit card. Residents then collect water samples from their taps, and return them to Bernardsville on June 9th. Instructions are provided with each kit and results are emailed about 2-3 weeks later. Community well testing is open to everyone, regardless of municipality. For more info, online ordering, and other RHA well testing dates visit www.testmywell.org

Easy Grilled Shrimp with Cilantro Salsa Verde

Ingredients:

- 1 cup fresh cilantro leaves and stems, coarsely chopped
- ¼ cup fresh flat-leaf parsley leaves, coarsely chopped
- 2 cloves garlic, halved
- 2 limes, juiced
- 4 tablespoons olive oil
- 1/2 teaspoon salt, divided
- ¼ teaspoon ground pepper
- 1 (15 ox) can no-salt-added white beans, rinsed
- 1 pint grape tomatoes, halved
- 1 medium cucumber, seeded and chopped
- 1 lb large (21-25 ct) shrimp, peeled and deveined

Instructions:

- 1. Preheat grill to medium-high
- 2. Combine cilantro, parsley, garlic, lime juice, oil, ¼ tsp salt and pepper in a mini food processor. Process until the herbs are finely chopped. Reserve ¼ cup of the salsa. Transfer the rest to a medium bowl and add beans, tomatoes, and cucumber; stir to combine.
- 3. Thread shrimp onto four 12-inch metal or bamboo skewers and sprinkle with the remaining ¼ tsp salt. Grill the shrimp, turning once, until they turn pink and opaque, 2-3 minutes per side.
- 4. Serve the shrimp over the vegetable mixture, drizzled with the reserved salsa. Garnish with additional cilantro if desired.
