TITLE: RESOLUTION WAIVING CERTAIN FEES AND APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS DURING COVID-19 STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Governor Phil Murphy issued Executive Order 103 on March 9, 2020 declaring and proclaiming a public health emergency and state of emergency in the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Governor Murphy thereafter issued Executive Order 107 on March 21, 2020 which provided in relevant part:

"The brick and mortar premises of all non-essential retail businesses must close to the public as long as this Order remains in effect"; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 107 allowed essential retail businesses to remain open but with very strict restrictions; and

WHEREAS, Governor Murphy issued Executive Order 108 on March 21, 2020 preempting all local regulations and orders issued in response to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Governor Murphy issued Executive Order 142 on May 13, 2020 relaxing restrictions on non-essential retail businesses to allow curbside service; and

WHEREAS, Borough Land Use Ordinance § 23-4 PROHIBITED USES. [Ord. No. 751 § 24-4] provides that any use not expressly permitted by this chapter shall be prohibited;

WHEREAS, Borough Land Use Ordinance § 23-40.19 Outdoor Dining. [Ord. No. 966 § 2] permits outdoor dining in a Borough right of way upon certain conditions subject to filing and approval of a site plan (the "Outdoor Dining Ordinance");

WHEREAS, no Borough Ordinance permits side walk sales;

WHEREAS, Borough Ordinance § 5-11 entitled SPECIAL USE PERMITS [Ord. No. 931] permits the Borough Council of the Borough of Peapack and Gladstone to grant a Special Use Permit to an applicant to permit the temporary use of any property or structure for a purpose not otherwise permitted by the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Peapack and Gladstone upon certain conditions, including but not limited to the payment of a \$100.00 fee and \$1,000.00 escrow (the "Special Use Permit Ordinance");

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Peapack and Gladstone Borough Council as follows:

- 1. Food establishments in the Village Zone that have not previously been approved for an Outdoor Dining permit may utilize the Special Use Permit Ordinance to apply for a temporary Outdoor Dining Permit without resort to filing a site plan with the Borough but in all other respects such application shall be consistent with the Outdoor Dining Ordinance, specifically Subsections a, b, c and d thereof;
- 2. All other business establishments in the Village Zone may apply for a Special Use Permit to conduct outdoor business and sales;
- 3. In order to expedite the processing of Special Use Permit applications, the following Sections of the Special Use Permit Ordinance shall be waived until Executive Order 103 is rescinded:
 - a. § 5-11.3 Application; Fee;
 - b. § 5-11.4 Escrow Deposit; and
 - c. § 5-11.5 Notice to Property Owners.
- 4. To further expedite the processing of Special Use Permit applications, the following Sections of the Special Use Permit Ordinance shall be delegated to the Zoning Officer and the Police until Executive Order 103 is rescinded:
 - a. Granting of the Special Use Permit pursuant to § 5-11.1 Purpose; and
- b. Imposition of Conditions pursuant to § 5-11.2 Conditions for Issuance and § 5-11.7 Additional Conditions.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Borough Council reserves the right to review and, if necessary, modify or rescind the approval of the Special Use Application at any time.

- 5. The provisions of this resolution shall be liberally construed to effectively carry out it's purposes which are hereby found and declared to be in furtherance of the public health, safety and welfare
- 6. Sale of alcoholic beverages in connection with outdoor dining permitted pursuant to this Resolution shall be limited by the establishment's liquor license and the applicable rules and regulations of the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control as may be modified during this COVID-19 emergency.
- 7. This resolution does not repeal or amend any Borough land use ordinances or land development approvals and all land use ordinances and development approvals will be strictly enforced upon termination of this resolution.

- 8. All businesses must comply with the COVID-19 executive orders issued by Governor Murphy, and those executive orders will supersede anything in this resolution which is inconsistent with those orders.
- 9. All local businesses must comply with all applicable health statutes, ordinances and regulations, and must obtain any and all permits required by the Borough of Health.
- 10. All local businesses must comply with all orders and directives issued by the Chief of Police.
- 11. This Resolution shall take effect when the activities authorized herein are permitted by State statute, regulation or executive order and shall expire on the first to occur of the rescission of Executive Order 103 or December 31, 2020, <u>unless further action is taken</u> by the governing body.
